**BRIEFING ORDER**

IT APPEARING that Plaintiff, Directional One Services, U.S.A., by counsel, has filed a Motion for Rule 37(b) Sanctions, it is ORDERED pursuant to Rule 22 of the West Virginia Trial Court Rules as follows:

That movant will provide a proposed order (if not already done) and serve a copy upon all non-moving parties. Non-moving parties shall file written responses and proposed orders within **five (5) days** of entry of this order and serve copies of the same on the moving party. Thereafter, the Court will rule upon the motion on the pleadings and record or schedule a hearing if the Court deems it necessary.


Further, the Court reiterates its finding made in its Order entered October 21, 2019, wherein the Court granted Plaintiff's oral motion to re-depose Mr. Kilstrom at a time agreed to by the parties. *See* Ord., 10/21/19, p. 3. Further, the Court instructs counsel that Mr. Kilstrom must be made available for said re-deposition prior to the scheduled pretrial conference in this matter, set for December 2, 2019. Failure to re-depose Mr. Kilstrom prior to said December 2, 2019 pretrial conference may have a bearing on the testimony and evidence Mr. Kilstrom would be permitted to provide at the trial in this matter.
