TRIAL ORDER
DAY FOUR: AUGUST 29, 2020

3. Thereafter, the jury notified the Court that they had arrived at a verdict. At 11:07 p.m. the jury was returned to the courtroom. Court resumed with the reading of the verdict, which is set forth on the *Verdict Form* as filed with the Clerk. Counsel did not request that the jury be polled.

4. WHEREUPON, the jury was dismissed with the appreciation of the Court.

5. After the jury was dismissed, Plaintiff indicated it did not have any motions at this time.

6. Upon inquiry from Mr. Kamper regarding the previous judgment, the Court directed Mr. Kamper to prepare an Order with regard to the judgment in the summary judgment *Order*.

7. At 11:17 a.m., the proceedings adjourned for the day.


